

## CE Logs for Multi-Speaker Events

The Veterinary Medical Board (VMB) has begun auditing CE. A random selection of RVTs and DVMs will be asked to provide proof of attendance at the required CE. For RVTs, the requirement is 16 hours of “interactive “ CE and 4 hours of “passive” CE every 2 years. Interactive means that there is a live person at the other end. Passive means there is no live person, and includes things like reading journals and watching recorded webinars.

The VMB has also stated that attendees at multi-speaker events will be required to provide a “log” which includes the title of the lecture and the name of the lecturer for each lecture attended at a multi-speaker event. The log can be filled out by the licensee and does not need to be signed by anyone else. The log is in addition to the Certificate of Attendance for the entire event.

For example, an RVT who attends the Back-to-School Conference will need to have both the Certificate of Attendance provided by UC Davis and a log of the individual lectures attended at the conference. Logs will be provided for attendees at this conference. However, many conferences do not provide logs, which means that attendees will need to provide their own.

CaRVTA has designed a generic log that attendees can use at any conference. RVTs who are attending any conference other than Back-to-School should bring a copy of the log with them so they can fill it out at the conference. The log should be saved along with the Certificate of Attendance for each conference. You can download a copy of the log [HERE](#).
