The Humane Society of San Bernardino Valley (HSSBV) is expanding programs and services offered in the San Bernardino community. Our Wellness Clinic currently employs two Veterinarians, three Registered Veterinary Technicians and nine Veterinary Assistants. Many of our staff have been with the Humane Society for years.

We are looking for caring, energetic Registered Veterinary Technicians to join our team.

Our 17,000 sq. ft. Veterinary Clinic and Education Center provides quality spay/neuter services and minor surgical procedures to over 9,000 dogs and cats a year. Our wellness clinic provides basic wellness and medical services to pets in our community. Our mission also includes a strong focus on client education.

We are a private non-profit facility, not an animal shelter or animal control agency.

We have been dedicated to reducing the pet overpopulation problem in the inland empire for over 45 years.

The R.V.T will provide medical care and assistance to pets at the Humane Society's Veterinary Clinic. This includes checking in patients and preparing them for surgery, performing dental procedures, administering vaccinations, medications and euthanasia. The RVT will examine pets under the supervision of the staff veterinarians and will provide emergency assistance to all pets in need, in addition to performing in-house diagnostic laboratory tests and other duties as assigned.

The applicant must have the following:

1. California State Registered Veterinary Technician license.
2. Knowledge of animal behavior and anatomy, handling and restraint, kennel procedures.
3. Knowledge of disease common to domestic animals and their symptoms; ability to administer medications.
4. Knowledge of sterile techniques, catheter placement, anesthetic techniques.
5. Ability to communicate, to write effectively, perform basic mathematics and follow direction in a busy environment.
6. Able to lift up to fifty pounds.
