The RVT/Veterinary Assistant is responsible for providing high quality, humane animal care while maintaining the highest standard of medical care for a busy shelter medical dept. Our medical team provides a crucial service to our shelter animals and to our community through HSSC's public-facing Community Veterinary Clinic by offering low-cost medical care for individuals in the community who qualify based on income.

This position will perform pre-surgical exams, inducing anesthesia, monitoring animals under anesthesia, recovering animals from anesthesia, and oversight/training of vet assistants. The RVT will assist our DVM's with exams, perform diagnostics, treatments, and anesthetic procedures, communicate treatment plans with owners, discharge patients, and other tasks as needed.

Minimum of 1-2-years' experience working in a fast-paced veterinary practice and/or an exceptionally mature and hard-working attitude.

Knowledge of medications including controlled drugs.

Ability to work independently as well as being a team member.
