**About the Job:** As a Vet Tech in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) you will be responsible for:

- Collecting samples, placing IV catheters, prepare IV fluids and additives, obtain arterial blood gas samples
- Calculating and administering medication, fluid additives, CRI's
- Obtaining and reporting vitals, monitoring telemetry, monitor oxygen dependent patients
- Placement and maintenance of nasogastric tube, nasal cannula, central venous catheters
- Must be able to prioritize patient hourly treatments and delegate tasks. Triage critical patients, recognize changes in patient status and report to doctor, educate/update owners on patient status, discharge patients from the hospital.
